UKRAINE WAR | POTUS weighs heavy tariffs, sanctions on Russia amid faltering diplomacy

Trump's 2-week ultimatum again

WASHINGTON

US President Donald Trump said on Friday he will give Russian President Vladimir Putin "a couple of weeks," extending his deadline for potential consequences against Moscow after urging the Russian leader to meet his Ukrainian counterpart in hopes of ending the war.

If there's a possibility he does nothing if Putin doesn't come to the table, Trump said, "We'll see. I'll see whose fault it is." "If there are reasons why, I will understand that; I know exactly what I'm doing. We're going to see if or not they have a meeting, that will be interesting to see, and if they don't, why didn't they have a meeting? Because I told them to have a meeting," Trump said.

"But I'll know in two weeks what I'm going to do," Trump added, reprising a timeline he's repeatedly issued to determine Putin's willingness to end the war in Ukraine.

Sergey Lavrov said on Friday there were no plans for a meeting between the two leaders. "You understand I wanted to have a meeting with those two. I could have been at the meeting, but a lot of people think nothing's going to come out of that meeting. You have to be there." Maybe that's true. Maybe it's not, but we're going to see in the meantime, people continue to die," Trump said.

He repeated his two-week timeframe several times. "We'll see what happens. I think in two weeks, we'll know which way I'm going, because I'm going to go one way or the other, and they'll learn which way."

Trump also pulled out from the Resolute Desk a photo of him and Putin in Anchorage, Alaska, that he said the Russian leader had sent him.

"I was just sent a picture from someone who wants to be there very badly," Trump said, referring to the World Cup. He'd convened reporters in the Oval Office to announce the draw would be held at the Kennedy Center in December.

"He's been very respectful of me and of our country, but not so respectful of others," Trump said, adding, he was going to sign the photo for Putin, who he suggested could be coming to the US for the World Cup. "He may be coming and he may not, depending on what happens. We have a lot of things happening over the next couple of weeks," Trump said.

Putin on Friday described his recent meeting with Trump as "very good" and said Russia sought an end to the war in Ukraine. However, he made no mention of whether he would attend bilateral talks with Zelensky.

He added Russian and US agencies were continuing to communicate and he expects a "full-scale restoration" of their relationship.

Tariff tensions with US: India hires lobbying firm

'Delhi needs pool of int'l mediators'

Singapore: India must build a strong pool of international mediators to manage trade and contract disputes as its economy expands at 6.5%, said a Singapore International Mediation Centre official. "We are seeing an increasing number of mediation cases from India, which is a global market and a leading member of the global supply chain. This means there is an urgent need to build mediation capacity in the country," SIMC CEO Chuan Wee Meng said. He noted mediation is becoming the preferred way to resolve disputes as it is quicker and less costly than arbitration. SIMC plans to resume training programmes for mediators, including law experts from India, to meet the growing demand.

However, Mercury is not the only lobbying firm India has engaged. The short-term agreement with Mercury supplements India's existing \$1.8 million annual contract with SHW Partners LLC, led by former Trump adviser Jason Miller, which focuses on strategic counsel, government relations, and public perception management.

White House trade adviser Peter Navarro expressed skepticism about India's willingness to adjust its energy ties with Russia. He said, "India doesn't appear to want to recognise its role in the bloodshed. It simply doesn't."

Meanwhile, Pakistan is outpacing India in lobbying expenditures to build ties, spending \$600,000 a month to influence DC. Despite economic challenges, Pakistan has engaged six lobbying and strategic communications firms to strengthen ties with the White House, Congress, and US agencies.

Further, Indian envoy to the US Vinay Mohan Kwatra met more US lawmakers to discuss "balanced trade ties". He met Rep Claudia Tenney, Member of Ways and Means Committee and House Intelligence Committee, and had an in-depth conversation on the importance of fair and balanced trade ties.

US govt buys 10% stake in Intel

President Trump has announced the US government has secured a 10% stake in struggling Silicon Valley pioneer Intel in a deal completed weeks after he was depicting the firm's CEO as a conflicted leader unfit for the job. "The USA now fully owns and controls 10% of INTEL, a Great American Company that has an even more incredible future," Trump wrote in a social media post on Friday.

The US government is getting the stake through the conversion of \$11.1 billion in previously issued funds and pledges. The government is getting 433.3 million shares of non-voting stock priced at \$20.47 apiece — a discount

from Friday's closing price at \$24.80. That spread means the US government already has a gain of \$1.9 billion, on paper.

The remarkable turn of events makes the US government one of Intel's largest shareholders at a time that the Santa Clara, California, company is in the process of jettisoning over 20,000 workers as part of its latest bid to bounce back from years of missteps taken under a variety of CEOs.

Intel CEO Lip-Bu Tan has been on the job for over five months. Earlier this month, it looked like he might be on shaky ground after some lawmakers raised national security concerns about his investments in Chinese firms while he was a venture capitalist.

Slept with him once: Ghislaine Maxwell on first encounter with Jeffery Epstein



Washington: Ghislaine Maxwell, the convicted associate of sex offender Jeffery Epstein, revealed she "slept" with him just once thinking that they were soon going to start dating. In her interview with the US Department of Justice, she recalled: "I slept with him one time and thought, 'we're going to be dating.'" "That's the world I came from," she said.

Deputy Attorney General Todd Blanche conducted the interview last month in Florida, during which Maxwell described how she believed their relationship was heading towards romance, only to find herself increasingly entangled in Epstein's affairs.

Now a federal prisoner, she recounted that in 1991 she was introduced to Epstein, who, at

that point, she described Epstein as her "lifeline." Over time, Maxwell said, she began to see herself as the "general manager" of the convicted paedophile's property empire, while also becoming involved in his private life, according to audio tapes and transcripts released on Friday.

Between 1992 and 1996, their professional and personal lives grew intertwined. They travelled together, and while they often shared a bed, Maxwell said they seldom had intercourse. "Epstein told me he had a heart condition, which meant he didn't have intercourse a lot, which suited me fine, as I actually do have a medical condition which precludes me from having a lot of intercourse," she said. "Epstein liked other forms of sexual ac-

tivities," she added.

Maxwell said she joined his payroll, starting with an \$25,000 a year, rising to \$250,000 as she assumed responsibility for managing his multi-million-dollar assets.

Maxwell claimed their sexual relationship began to fade after 1999. She considered 9/11 the point at which she realised their romance had ended. "It was a scary time if you were in New York. He was on 71st Street, I was on 65th Street at my house. He would not come see me. Then I knew if you are not going to be there for someone on 9/11, you are never going to be there. For me, that was the line's end," she said.

Maxwell said she did not witness any inappropriate conduct by Donald Trump or former President Bill Clinton.

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Ranil shifted to ICU after remand

Colombo: Sri Lanka's former president Ranil Wickremesinghe was on Saturday shifted to the ICU of the Colombo National Hospital, a day after he was arrested and refused bail over alleged misuse of state funds during his tenure.

Wickremesinghe, 76, was taken to the main Magazine Remand prison close to midnight on Friday after the Colombo Fort magistrate's court remanded him till August 26. He was admitted to the prison hospital as his blood sugar and BP levels were high, prison spokesman Jagath Weerasinghe said.

By afternoon, there was no improvement and the prison doctors opined he should be transferred to the Colombo National Hospital.

Pak's FM in B'desh to reset ties, 1st in 13 yrs

Dhaka: Pakistan's Foreign Minister Ishaq Dar arrived in Dhaka on Saturday for a rare 2-day visit, aimed at rebuilding ties with Bangladesh following the ouster of longtime prime minister Sheikh Hasina. A special flight carrying Dar, the most senior Pakistani leader to visit Bangladesh since 2012, arrived in Dhaka, with Islamabad calling it a "significant milestone" in bilateral relations.

Bangladesh's Foreign Secretary Asad Alam Siam received Dar at Dhaka's Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport. Hina Rabbani

Khar was the last Pakistani foreign minister to visit Dhaka in November 2012 to invite then premier Hasina to a summit in Islamabad.

Officials said the Pakistani diplomat will hold bilateral talks on Sunday with Foreign Affairs Adviser Touhid Hossain, and sign half a dozen agreements and MoUs. "He (Dar) is expected to pay a courtesy call on Chief Adviser Muhammad Yunus. Meetings are expected with BNP (Bangladesh Nationalist Party) Chairperson Khaleda Zia and leaders of Jamaat-e-Islami," an official said.

Musk Macrohard vs Gates' MS

Elon Musk has set his sights on Microsoft with a new company called "Macrohard," a software venture tied to his AI startup, xAI.

Musk described the project as a "purely AI software company" that's designed to generate hundreds of specialised coding and generative AI agents that could one day simulate products from companies like Microsoft entirely through AI. Musk announced Macrohard on Friday, though xAI had

registered the trademark with the US Patent Office a few weeks ago, as noted in a PC Mag report.

Last month, Musk said xAI was "creating a multi-agent AI software firm, where Grok spawns hundreds of specialised coding and image/video generation/understanding agents working together and emulates humans interacting with the software in virtual machines till the result is excellent."

NSC ministers resign, Dutch govt in crisis

The Hague: The political crisis in the Netherlands escalated after all ministers from the New Social Contract party resigned from the caretaker government, following the departure of Foreign Minister **Caspar Veldkamp**. Veldkamp announced his resignation in The Hague on Friday, citing frustration over restrictions on measures against Israel.

"I see that I cannot take sufficiently meaningful additional measures to increase pressure on Israel," he told reporters

after a Council of Ministers meeting.

His departure triggered a collective exit by fellow NSC ministers — Eddy van Hijum (Social Affairs), Eppo Bruins (Education), Judith Uitermark (Interior), Danielle Jansen (Health) — and 4 state secretaries. The move destabilises the fragile coalition, reports Xinhua news agency.

During Thursday's parliamentary debate, left-wing opposition parties argued the government was not doing enough. The Socialist Party

(SP), backed by the Party for the Animals (PvdD) and migrant party Denk, tabled a motion of no confidence against Veldkamp. However, his resignation rendered the motion unnecessary.

In late July, Veldkamp had declared two Israeli cabinet ministers persona non grata and ordered their entry into the Schengen Information System as unwelcome individuals, citing their "repeated incitement of settler violence against the Palestinian population..."
